Calvary Dress Code for Homecoming Dance

For all CBA High School students, Homecoming is a signature experience of the school year. This event is designed to be fun and enjoyable, while still honoring the Lord at the same time.

Because of this, there are firm guidelines as to what is appropriate dress for both young men and young women. These guidelines are listed below. Please be sure to review these guidelines before renting/purchasing garments.

Any students from other schools attending this event are required to follow the same guidelines and are responsibility of the CBA student who is hosting them.

With modesty in mind, the following dress code guidelines will be followed at all CBA formal events:

Gentlemen must wear either a suit and tie or a dress shirt, tie, and dress pants.

Ladies must be sure that their dresses:

- Do not show skin lower than 2 inches below the bra line in the back
- Show no cleavage
- Does not hug the rear or thighs. Ladies should be able to pull the fabric away from these areas.
- Are no shorter than 4 inches above the knee at the shortest non-sheer point.. This includes slits.
- Two piece dresses are allowed... No bare midriff showing.

Failure to wear the approved clothing will result in NON ENTRY TO THE EVENT.
