

Hey CAVS kids—

Join the CAVS Summer Reading Club!!

All of our K-3rd grade students are challenged to keep reading this summer.

Here are the reading goals:

Kindergarteners going into 1st grade—3 books (Easy readers read with an adult)

1st graders going into 2nd grade—5 books that they should read independently

2nd graders going into 3rd grade—7 books

3rd graders going into 4th grade—**Read one chapter book from the list given by 4th grade—PLUS—one additional chapter book of your child's choice**

For students entering 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grades, there are no requirements regarding the kind of books they choose (reading level, type of book, specific titles, etc.). For students entering 4th grade, one book should be read from the list provided plus one additional chapter book (The second book can come from the list or be a book chosen by student.) Students should record their book titles on the Reading Log on the back of this sheet. Keep the Reading Log in a safe place and return it to their new teacher by Friday, August 8. All students returning their Reading Log with the required number of books will receive a “Popsicle Ticket” for a popsicle at recess on Friday, August 15.

In addition to completing the CAVS Reading Log, I have also encouraged students to visit the public library this summer. Public libraries in each parish offer a summer reading program, “Color Our World.” It is free and registration is now open online through each library’s website. Websites for local parishes are:

Those who complete public library’s summer reading challenge will receive an assortment of prizes including tote bags, books, pencils, erasers, and other promotional items. Further, each library branch offers free activities and presentations throughout the summer. When you visit the branch of your choice, you can pick up a calendar of free events offered at that branch. You and your little CAVS will enjoy all the wonderful, fun activities that the public libraries have to offer.

I have thoroughly enjoyed sharing and fostering the love of reading with all of our CAVS kids this school year. I wish everyone a wonderful summer. Keep reading, and I will see in you in August!
